Membership Roster, Constitution and By-laws of the Rotary Club of Bangor, 1963

Rotary Club, Bangor, Maine

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adult male persons of good character and good professional reputation engaged in any worthy and recognized profession.

Section 3. Classifications. (a) The active members of this club shall be classified, in accordance with their respective businesses or professions, and they must be personally and actively engaged therein within the territorial limits of the club.

(b) The classification of each active member shall be that which covers the principal and recognized activity of the firm, company or institution with which he is connected, or if he be independently engaged in a business or profession, his classification shall be that which covers his principal and recognized business or professional activity.

Section 4. Limitations. The active membership shall consist of but one man from each classification of business or profession, excepting the newspaper classification, and excepting the provision for an additional active member, as hereinafter provided.

Section 5. Additional Active Member. Any active member of this club may propose for and the club may elect to active membership one additional man from the concern or establishment with which the proposer is connected, whose classification shall be the same as that of the proposer. The qualifications of such additional member shall be those required for active membership.

Section 6. Newspaper Classification. Representatives of more than one newspaper published within the territorial limits of this club may be eligible to active membership under the same classification, provided that they otherwise possess the qualifications for active membership.

Section 7. Public Office Holder. Persons holding elective or appointive public office for a specified time only shall not be eligible to active membership in this club under the classification of such office. This shall not apply to persons holding a position or office in schools, colleges or other institutions of learning.

Section 8. Local Preference. No man engaged as the local agent or branch representative of an outside concern shall be eligible to active membership, when a suitable applicant may be available whose principal place of business is within the territorial limits of this club.

Section 9.—(a) Honorary Membership—Qualifications. An adult male person who has distinguished himself by meritorious service in the furtherance of Rotary ideals and who resides within or who is definitely associated with the territorial limits of the club, may be elected to honorary membership in the club.

(b) Honorary Membership—Conditions. Honorary members shall be exempt from payment of admission fees and dues, shall have no vote and shall not be eligible to hold any office in the club; shall have no interest in any property of the club; shall not be considered as representing any business or professional classification, but shall be entitled to attend all meetings and enjoy all other privileges of the club.

Section 10. Past Service Membership. A former active member of a Rotary Club, who becomes ineligible to active membership because of his retirement from active business or professional life, may be elected to past service membership in this club provided he has held active membership in one or more Rotary clubs for five or more years. Such former member may be elected to past service membership at the time of, or at any time subsequent to, the termination of his active membership in a club, provided he has all the other qualifications for past service membership. If his retirement from business or professional life occurs after he has ceased to be a member of a Rotary Club, he is not eligible to past service membership. He must reside and continue to reside within the territorial limits of this club or within the residential territory recognized as the suburbs of the city in which this club is located.

A past service member shall have all the rights, privileges and responsibilities of an active member except that he shall not be considered as representing any business or professional classification.

Section 11. Senior Active Membership. Any active member of this club who now is and has been an active member of this or other Rotary clubs for a

total of twenty or more years, or who is of the age of sixty-five or more after having been an active member of one or more Rotary clubs for a total of five or more years, or who is a present or a past officer of Rotary International, may, at his option, become a senior active member of this club by notifying the secretary in writing of his intention so to do.

This club may, at its option, elect to senior active membership in this club, any former senior active member of any Rotary club provided such former senior active member resides within the territorial limits of this club or within the residential territory recognized as the suburbs of the city in which this club is located.

A senior active member shall have all the rights, privileges and responsibilities of an active member, except that he shall not be considered as representing any business or professional classification. This club may admit into its membership an adult male person in the classification of business or profession in which such senior active member may be engaged.

Article IV.

DURATION OF MEMBERSHIP

Section 1.—Period. Membership shall continue during the existence of the club unless terminated as hereinafter provided or by death of the member.

Section 2.—How Terminated. (a) Active membership shall automatically terminate if, and when, an active member ceases to be personally engaged within the territorial limits of the club in the classification of business or profession under which he is classified in the club, or his connection with his business establishment is severed.

(b) Additional active membership shall automatically terminate with the termination of the membership of the active member who proposed such additional active member, or in the event an active member becomes a senior active member of this club, the membership of the additional active member shall automatically terminate. If the man who has held such additional active membership is immediately reelected to active membership in this club, he shall not be required to pay a second admission fee.

(c) Honorary membership shall automatically terminate on the first day of July next after the date of election, provided, however, that the board of directors in its discretion may, by resolution, continue such honorary membership from year to year thereafter. Such honorary membership may be continued by the board although the person so elected has ceased to reside within or to be definitely associated with the territorial limits of the club.

(d) Past service membership shall automatically terminate if, and when, a past service member re-enters active business or professional life, or if, and when, he ceases to reside within the territorial limits of this club or within the residential territory recognized as the suburbs of the city in which this club is located.

(e) Senior active membership shall automatically terminate if, and when, a senior active member ceases to reside within the territorial limits of this club or within the residential territory recognized as the suburbs of the city in which this club is located.

Section 3. How to Rejoin. Where the membership of an active member has terminated as provided in the foregoing Section 2, such person may make new application for membership, and whether under the same classification or another classification, his application shall be considered, in advance of any other, for membership under the classification in which he now applies, and if elected to membership, he shall not be required to pay a second admission fee.

Section 4. Classification—How Corrected. The Board of Directors, in its discretion, may correct or readjust the classification of any member, whose membership has not terminated, if the circumstances warrant such action, but due notice of such proposed correction or readjustment shall be given to the member and he be allowed a hearing thereon.

Section 5.—Termination for Other Causes. (a) The membership of any member who shall cease to have the stated qualifications for membership in Rotary may be terminated by the Board of Directors by the votes of not less than two-thirds of the members thereof at the meeting called for that purpose.

(b) The membership of any member may be terminated by the Board of Directors, for a reason which the Board of Directors may deem to be sufficient, by the votes of not less than two-thirds of the members thereof, at a meeting called for that purpose.

(c) In either case (a) or (b) the member shall be given at least ten (10) days' notice in writing of such pending action in order that he may have the opportunity of appearing before the Board of Directors to state his case. Service of such notice shall be made by personal delivery or by registered letter to his last known address.

(d) In case of such decision to terminate membership the secretary shall within seven (7) days after the date of the board's decision, notify the member in writing of the decision of the board, and such former member may, within fourteen (14) days after the date of such notice, submit in writing to the secretary, notice of his election either to appeal to the club or to arbitrate as provided in Section 10 of this Article. In the event he elects to appeal, the Board of Directors shall thereupon set the date for the hearing of the appeal at a regular meeting of the club, to be held within twenty-one (21) days after the receipt of such written notice of appeal. At least five (5) days' notice of such club meeting and its special business shall be given in writing to every member of the club, and only at such meeting.

(e) Where the Board of Directors has terminated a membership as provided for in this section, the club shall not elect a new member under such classification until the time for hearing the appeal, if any, has expired and the club's decision or the award of the arbitrators announced.

(f) The action of the Board shall be final if no appeal to the club is taken and no arbitration is requested; but if an appeal is taken, then and in that event, the action of the club shall be final.

Section 6. Termination—Non-payment of Dues. Any member failing to pay his dues within thirty (30) days after the prescribed time shall be notified in writing by the secretary at his last known address, and if said dues are not paid on or before ten (10) days from date of such notification said membership shall automatically terminate.

Such former member, at the discretion of the Board, may be reinstated to membership upon his petition, and upon the payment of all his indebtedness to the club, provided his former classification has not been filled meanwhile by the election of a new member.

Section 7.—Termination—Non-attendance. (a) The membership of any active, past service, or senior active member who is absent from four consecutive regular weekly meetings of this club shall automatically terminate, unless such absence is made up as hereinafter provided, or he is excused by the Board of Directors for good and sufficient reason. Absence at a regular meeting of this club may be made up by attendance at a regular meeting of any other Rotary club on any of the six (6) days immediately preceding the day of absence, on the day of the absence itself, or on any of the six (6) days immediately following the day of absence, provided notice of such attendance is given to this club.

(b) The membership of any active, past service, or senior active member whose percentage of attendance is less than sixty per cent during the first or second six months of the club's fiscal year shall automatically terminate, unless he is excused by the Board of Directors for good and sufficient reason.

Section 8. Resignation. The resignation of any member from this club shall be in writing (addressed to the president or secretary) and shall be accepted by the Board of Directors, provided that all indebtedness of said member to the club has been paid.

Section 9. Property Interest—Forfeiture of. Any person whose membership in this club has been terminated in any manner shall forfeit all interest in any funds or other property belonging to the club.

Section 10. Arbitration. Should any dispute at any time arise between any member or members, or a past member or members, and the club, or any officer or the Board of Directors of the club, relative to membership, or to any alleged breach of the constitution or by-laws, or the expulsion of any member from the club, or on any account whatsoever which cannot be satisfactorily settled upon the procedure already provided for such purpose, the matters in difference shall be settled by arbitration in the usual manner, each party to appoint

an arbitrator and the arbitrators to appoint an umpire. The arbitration shall be conducted in the manner prescribed by law and the decision arrived at by the arbitrators, or, in the event of their disagreement, by the umpire, shall be final and binding on all parties.

Article V.

TERRITORIAL LIMITS

Section 1. The territorial limits of this organization shall be as follows: Within ten miles of Bangor.

(Note: These territorial limits are understood to include the immediately tributary rural territory for which the community in which the club is located is the principal banking, trading and shipping center.)

Article VI.

MEETINGS

Section 1. This club shall meet regularly once each week as provided in the by-laws.

Section 2. The annual meeting and election of this club shall be held in the month of April or May, as provided in the by-laws.

Article VII.

ADMISSION FEE AND DUES

Section 1. Every active, past service, and senior active member of this club shall pay as an admission fee and as annual dues such sums as may be prescribed in the by-laws of this club except that a past service or senior active member who has held active membership in this club shall not be required to pay a second admission fee.

Article VIII.

OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS

Section 1. The governing body of this club shall be a Board of Directors to be constituted as the by-laws of the club may provide.

Section 2. The decision of the Board in all club matters shall be final, subject only to an appeal to the club. The Board shall have general control over all officers and committees and may, for good cause, declare any office vacant. It shall constitute a board of appeal from the rulings of all officers and actions of all committees. Appeal may be taken from any decision of the Board of Directors to the club and on such appeal the decision appealed from shall be

reversed only by a two-thirds vote of the members present, at a regular meeting to be specified by the Board of Directors, a quorum being present, notice of such appeal having been given by the secretary to all members of the club at least five days in advance of such meeting.

Section 3. The officers of this club shall be a President, one or more Vice-Presidents, all of whom shall be members of the Board of Directors, and a Secretary, a Treasurer, and a Sergeant-at-Arms, any or all of whom may or may not be members of the Board of Directors as the by-laws of the club shall provide.

Section 4. These officers shall take office on the first day of July following their election and shall hold office for one year or until successors have been elected and have qualified.

Each officer and each director shall be an active, or a past service, or a senior active member in good standing of this club.

Article IX.

AVOIDANCE OF POLITICS

Section 1. This club shall not endorse or recommend any candidate for public office and shall not discuss at any club meeting the merits or demerits of any such candidate.

Section 2. The merits of any public question involving the social, economic, moral or physical welfare of the people may be fairly and intelligently studied and discussed before a club meeting for the enlightenment of its members, but this club shall not take any action endorsing or condemning any measure which is to be submitted to the vote of the people.

Article X.

OFFICIAL PUBLICATION

Section 1. Acceptance of active or past service membership in this club shall be a declaration by each person, so doing, that he voluntarily becomes a bona fide subscriber to the monthly publication of Rotary International. His subscription shall be handled in six-month periods and shall continue as long as he is a member of the club and to the end of any six-month period during which he may cease to be a member of the club.

Section 2. The amount of the subscription shall be collected by the club from each member, semi-annually in advance. The secretary shall enter such subscriptions and amounts so collected in a special subscription account and remit to the business office of said publication.

Section 3. The Board of Directors of Rotary International may prescribe this standard Club Constitution without this article for the use of clubs outside of the United States, Canada and Newfoundland.

Article XI.

ACCEPTANCE OF OBJECTS AND COMPLIANCE WITH CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS

A member by payment of his admission fee and dues thereby accepts the principles of Rotary as expressed in its Objects and submits himself to and agrees to comply with and be bound by the constitution and by-laws of this club, and on these conditions alone is entitled to the privileges of the club. No member shall be absolved from the observance of the constitution and by-laws on the plea that he has not received a copy of them.

Article XII.

BY-LAWS

Section 1. This club shall adopt by-laws not inconsistent with the Constitution and By-Laws of Rotary International (and the rules of procedure for an area administration where established) and this Constitution, embodying additional provisions for the government of this club, which adoption shall be by a majority vote of the members of the club present and voting and may be amended from time to time in accordance with the provisions therein contained.

Article XIII.

AMENDMENTS

Section 1. Amendments to this constitution, except as provided in Section 4 of this Article, shall be made only at a convention of Rotary International by a majority vote of the electors present and voting at the time such amendments are submitted to the convention provided that no proposed amendment shall be acted upon at any convention unless the text (which

may or may not be amended as provided in Section 3 of this Article) of such proposed amendment shall have been delivered to the secretary of Rotary International not later than the first day of February immediately preceding the date of opening of such convention, and unless a copy thereof shall have been mailed to the secretary of each member club not later than the first day of March immediately preceding the opening of such convention, provided, however, that in the event the Board of Directors fixes the date of the convention for a date prior to June fifth then the dates on which said proposed amendments shall be filed and mailed shall be advanced by the same number of days as that by which such convention date is advanced. It shall be the duty of the secretary of Rotary International to cause such copies to be mailed.

Section 2. Amendments to this constitution, except as provided in Section 4 of this Article, may be proposed only by a member club, by a district conference, by the general council or the conference of a territorial unit, by the council on legislation, and by the board of directors of Rotary International.

Section 3. It shall be the duty of the secretary to transmit directly to the council on legislation all duly proposed amendments, except as provided in Section 4 of this Article. The council on legislation shall consider and act upon all such proposed enactments with or without amendment and shall report its action on all enactments to a session of the voting delegates of the convention for such action as they may determine.

Section 4. Article I (Name) and Article V (Territorial Limits) of this constitution may be amended at any regular meeting of this club, a quorum being present, by a two-thirds vote of all members present, provided that notice of such proposed amendment shall have been mailed to each member at least ten (10) days before such meeting, and provided further, that such amendment shall be submitted to the board of directors of Rotary International for its approval and shall become effective only when so approved.

BY-LAWS

Article I.

ELECTION OF DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS

Section 1. At the regular meeting one month prior to the Annual Meeting the presiding officer shall appoint a nominating committee to present at the Annual Meeting nominations for president, vice-president, secretary, treasurer and two members of the Board of Directors. Nominations may also be presented by members from the floor at the Annual Meeting. The election of the officers and directors shall be made by ballot from the list of duly nominated candidates.

Section 2. The officers and directors, so elected, together with the immediate past president, shall constitute the Board of Directors.

Section 3. At the first meeting of the newly elected Board of Directors they shall elect some member of the club to act as sergeant-at-arms.

Section 4. A vacancy in the Board of Directors or any office shall be filled by the remaining members of the Board.

Article II.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section 1. The governing body of this club shall be the Board of Directors, consisting of seven members of this club, namely, two directors elected in accordance with Art. I, Sec. 1, of these by-laws, the president, vice-president, secretary, treasurer and the immediate past president.

Article III.

DUTIES OF OFFICERS

Section 1. President. It shall be the duty of the president to preside at meetings of the club and Board of Directors and to perform such other duties as ordinarily pertain to his office.

Section 2. Vice-President. It shall be the duty of the vice-president to preside at meetings of the club and Board of Directors in the absence of the president and to perform such other duties as ordinarily pertain to his office.

Section 3. Secretary. It shall be the duty of the secretary to keep the records of membership, record the attendance

Section 4. Regular meetings of the Board of Directors shall be held each month at such time and place as they may from time to time designate. Special meetings of the Board of Directors shall be called by the president whenever deemed necessary, or upon the request of two members of the Board, due notice having been given.

Section 5. A majority of the board members shall constitute a quorum of the Board of Directors.

Article V.

FEES AND DUES

Section 1. The admission fee shall be \$25.00 to be paid before the applicant can qualify as a member.

Section 2. The membership dues shall be \$25.00 per annum, payable in advance on the first day of July in each year. Members joining after the annual meeting shall pay in addition to the admission fee a full year's dues, except such members as join after January 1st, who shall pay one half of the annual dues for the balance of the Club year.

Section 3. The above annual dues shall cover the subscription to the Official Monthly Publication of Rotary International, payment for which shall be made by the Club Treasurer.

Article VI.

METHOD OF VOTING

The business of this organization shall be transacted by viva voce vote except the election of directors which shall be by ballot.

Article VII.

COMMITTEES

Section 1. (a) The president shall, subject to the approval of the Board of Directors, appoint the following principal and standing committees:

- Aims and Objects Committee
- Club Service Committee
- Vocational Service Committee
- Community Service Committee
- International Service Committee

(b) The president shall, subject to the approval of the Board of Directors, also appoint the following committees on particular phases of Club Service:

- Classifications Committee
- Membership Committee
- Program Committee

Fellowship Committee

Rotary Information Committee

and any other committees that he may deem necessary for the internal administration of club affairs.

(c) The president shall, subject to the approval of the Board of Directors, also appoint a Boy's Work Committee, and any other committees that he may deem necessary on particular phases of Community Service.

(d) The president shall, subject to the approval of the Board of Directors, also appoint such committees on particular phases of Vocational Service and International Service as he may deem necessary.

(e) The president shall be ex-officio a member of all standing and special committees.

Section 2. (a) Aims and Objects Committee. The president shall be the chairman of the Aims and Objects Committee, which committee shall consist of himself, the secretary and the four chairmen of the Club Service Committee, the Vocational Service Committee, the Community Service Committee and the International Service Committee.

(b) Club Service Committee. This committee shall consist of a chairman, who shall be named by the president, and of the chairmen of the Classifications, Membership, Program, Fellowship and the Rotary Information Committees and of the chairmen of such other committees as may be appointed on particular phases of Club Service.

(c) Vocational Service Committee. This committee shall consist of a chairman, who shall be named by the president, and of not less than two other members; and in the event committees are appointed on particular phases of Vocational Service the chairmen of such committees shall be members of the Vocational Service Committee.

(d) Community Service Committee. This committee shall consist of a chairman, who shall be named by the president, the chairman of the Boys Work Committee and of not less than one other member; and in the event other committees are appointed on particular phases of Community Service the chairmen of such committees shall be members of the Community Service Committee.

(e) International Service Committee. This committee shall consist of a chairman, who shall be named by the president, and of not less than two other members; and in the event committees are appointed on particular phases of International Service the chairmen of such committees shall be members of the International Service Committee.

Section 3. Each committee shall transact such business as is delegated to it in the by-laws and such additional

business as may be referred to it by the president or the Board of Directors. Except where special authority is given by the Board of Directors, such committees shall not take final action until a report has been made to the Board and approved by them.

Article VIII.

DUTIES OF COMMITTEES

Section 1. Aims and Objects Committee. This committee shall prepare a comprehensive plan of activities for the club and shall supervise and coordinate the activities of the Club Service Committee, the Vocational Service Committee, the Community Service Committee and the International Service Committee, so as to develop throughout the club a wider and fuller understanding of the aims and objects of Rotary, and so as to provide the club with a comprehensive and co-ordinated program of activities.

Section 2. Club Service Committee. This committee shall supervise and coordinate the activities of the Classifications, Membership, Program, Fellowship and the Rotary Information Committees and such other committees as may be appointed on particular phases of Club Service, in order to develop the club machinery for the execution of the plans and program of the Aims and Objects Committee.

(a) *Classifications Committee.* This committee shall make a classification survey of the community; shall compile from the survey a roster of filled and unfilled classifications using the Outline of Classifications as a guide; shall urge upon the members the importance of proposing names for the unfilled classifications; shall review, where necessary, existing classifications represented in the club; and shall counsel with the Board of Directors on all classifications problems.

(b) *Membership Committee.* The personnel of this committee shall not be known by the Board of Directors or the membership at large. It shall investigate the character, business, social standing and general eligibility of persons proposed for membership and shall report their decision on all applications to the President.

(c) *Program Committee.* This committee shall prepare and arrange the programs for the regular and special meetings of the club, so designed and balanced as to carry into effect the plan of the Aims and Objects Committee.

(d) *Fellowship Committee.* This committee shall promote acquaintance and friendship among the members and do such work in pursuance of the general objects of the club

as may be assigned by the president or the Board of Directors.

(e) **Rotary Information Committee.** This committee shall devise and carry into effect plans (1) to give the members, especially the new members, an adequate understanding of the privileges and responsibilities of members, (2) to give the members and the public generally information about Rotary, its history, objects, scope and activities, and (3) to secure proper publicity for Rotary in general and the club in particular.

Section 3. Vocational Service Committee. This committee shall devise and carry into effect plans which will guide and assist the members of this club in discharging their responsibilities in their vocational relationships and in improving the general standards of practice in their respective vocations. In the event committees are appointed on particular phases of Vocational Service, this committee shall supervise and co-ordinate the activities of such committees.

Section 4. Community Service Committee. This committee shall devise and carry into effect plans which will guide and assist the members of this club in discharging their responsibilities in their community relationships; and shall supervise and co-ordinate the activities of the Boys Work Committee and any other committees which may be appointed on particular phases of Community Service.

(a) **Boys Work Committee.** This committee shall acquaint itself, through surveys and by other means, with the needs of the boy life of the community. It shall recommend such action as it believes may promote the development of boys into good citizens and carry out such boys work as the club may authorize.

Section 5. International Service Committee. This committee shall devise and carry into effect plans which will guide and assist the members of this club in discharging their responsibilities in matters relating to International Service. In the event committees are appointed on particular phases of International Service, this committee shall supervise and co-ordinate the activities of such committees.

Article IX.

LEAVE OF ABSENCE

Upon written application to the Board of Directors, setting forth good and sufficient cause, leave of absence may be granted excusing a member from attending the meetings of the club for a specified length of time.

(NOTE: Such leave of absence does operate to prevent a forfeiture of membership; it does not operate to give the club credit for the member's attendance. The excused member must be recorded as absent [unless he attends a regular meeting of some other club].)

Article X.

FINANCES

Section 1. The treasurer shall deposit all funds of the club in some bank to be named by the Board of Directors.

Section 2. All bills shall be paid only by checks signed by the treasurer upon vouchers signed by any two officers. A thorough audit by a certified public accountant or other qualified persons shall be made once each year of all the club's financial transactions.

Section 3. Officers having charge or control of funds shall give bond as may be required by the Board of Directors for the safe custody of the funds of the club, cost of bond to be borne by the club.

Section 4. The fiscal year of this club shall extend from July 1st to June 30th. The payment of per capita tax and magazine subscriptions to Rotary International shall be made on July 1st and January 1st of each year on the basis of the membership of the club on those dates.

Article XI.

METHOD OF ELECTING MEMBERS

Section 1. The name of the newly proposed member, having been proposed by a member in good standing, shall be submitted first to the Board of Directors, through the secretary, on a blank form known as the proposal card (use form prescribed by Rotary International). The Board of Directors shall then, through the president, refer it to the membership committee. The membership committee after making due investigation shall then proceed to vote and if not to exceed one negative vote is cast the name of the proposed member shall be considered eligible. The membership committee shall then report back to the Board of Directors, through the president, the action that they have taken thereon. The Board of Directors shall then review the action of the membership committee and sustain or reject the decision or refer it back to the membership committee for further consideration.

If the membership committee has reported favorably upon the name of the newly proposed member and the Board of Directors has sustained the action the secretary shall notify

each member of the club in writing giving the name of the proposed candidate, the firm represented and the classification under which he would be eligible. No member shall disclose the name of any person so proposed for membership until after final action is taken by the Board of Directors. A ten-day period shall then be allowed during which any member objecting to the election of the applicant shall notify the Board of Directors in writing, stating reasons for his objections.

After the expiration of the ten days the Board shall meet and consider such objections as may have been submitted. They shall then proceed to ballot and, if no negative votes are cast, the proposed member shall be considered duly elected, whereupon he shall be interviewed by the President or some one designated by him and if he elects to accept the proffer of membership he shall sign the regular form of application blank and shall qualify for membership in accordance with these By-laws.

Section 2. Honorary Members. The names of proposed candidates for honorary membership shall be submitted to the Board of Directors in writing, and the election shall be in the same form and manner as prescribed for an active member, no signed application being required.

Section 3. Past Service Members. A former active member of a Rotary club, who became ineligible to active membership because of his retirement from active business or past service membership, may apply or may be proposed for professional life and who has all the other qualifications for past service membership. If his election is recommended by the Board of Directors the proposed past service member shall be considered duly elected, and shall be notified of his election.

Article XII.

RESOLUTIONS AND SUBSCRIPTIONS

Section 1. No resolution or motion to commit this club on any matter shall be considered by the club until it has been considered by the Board of Directors. Such resolutions or motions, if offered at a club meeting, shall be referred, without discussion, to the Board, which after having given consideration to the matter, shall submit its recommendations to the club. Having received the recommendations of the Board, the club may then proceed to take such action as may seem proper to the majority.

Section 2. Any appeal to the club, or to its members as Rotarians, for charitable or other subscriptions shall be handled in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Section 1 of this Article.

AMENDMENTS

These by-laws may be amended at any regular meeting, a quorum being present, by a two-thirds vote of all members present, provided that notice of such proposed amendment shall have been mailed to each member at least ten days before such meeting. No amendment or addition to these by laws can be made which is not in harmony with the club constitution and with the Constitution and By-Laws of Rotary International.
