The Bapst football team turned in another winning season, posting a 6-3 record which, combined with last year's 7-1 record, gave Bapst its best back-to-back season in its history. In the state's 18-team classification, the Crusaders were ranked first or second throughout most of the season until they suffered one point losses to Biddeford and Brewer in the last two games, costing the Crusaders their first state title. Among the season's highlights we may recall Jim Baker's sensational 60 yard runback of a punt against Winslow; young Ron Soucie's fine passing against Stearns, Grover Coffin's dazzling touchdown runs against Rockland; the revenge 26-6 victory over Madison; Dan Price zig-zagging his way to pay dirt against Old Town; Mike Baldacci's savage tackles; the fine all-around performance of Mike Scruggs, Ron Zuch and Don MacDonald in the Brewer game. Records were also shattered as Jim Baker set three which included most points for one season (74), most times carried (108), and most yardage gained in a season (743), Dick Giles set two punting records when he averaged 40 points on 17 punts, while his longest punt of 63 yards against Biddeford set another record. Grover Coffin set a record on 14 passes caught and Don MacDonald set a record by throwing 8 touchdown passes. Mike Baldacci and Jim Baker's selection to the All-East Team was the climax of a successful season.
