The 1975 Crusader Football Team under Head Coach Bob Brennan and his assistants Mike Connolly, Tom Coyne, Tony Disalvitore and Ken Zook posted a 7-2 record which was 2nd best in the Conference.

The Crusaders started their season with two losses to Stearns and Lincoln. As the younger players matured, with the help of Veterans, the Crusaders were able to win their last seven games in a row. High points of the season were the 40-8 trouncing of Dexter at Homecoming and the 24-16 defeat of Old Town which enabled the Crusaders to become Champions of the Penobscot Valley Conference and to obtain 2nd place in the Little Ten Conference.

On the field the Purple and White were led by Captain Mike Moore on defense, while junior Dennis Whitney directed the offense. Mark Dionne led the team in rushing with 560 yards, and Russ McKenna led the team in scoring with fifty-four points.

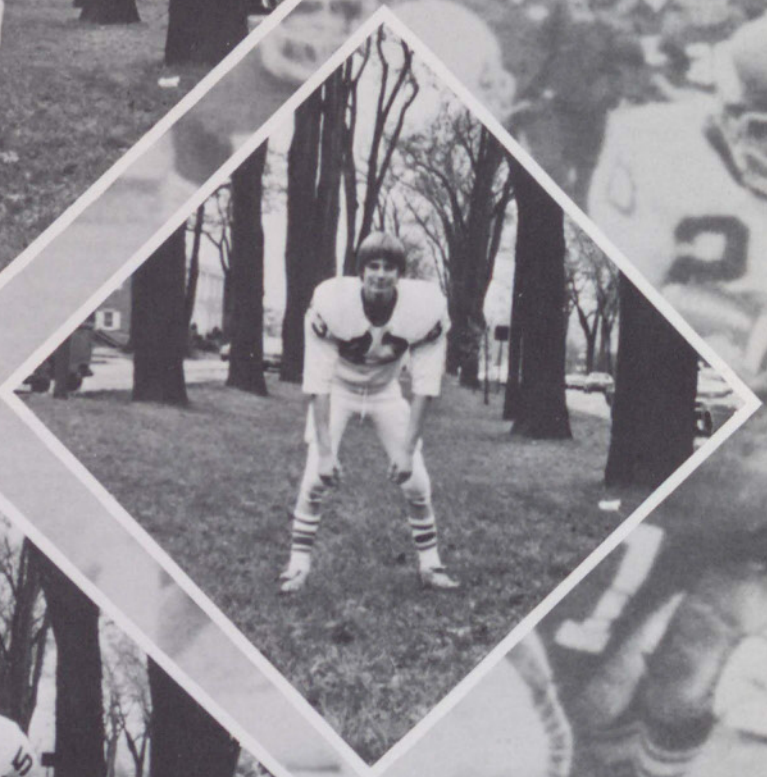
The Crusaders will be losing 6 seniors but can certainly be looking forward to another good season next year.
