DEDICATED TO OUR FRIEND H. EDWARD SAMWAYS



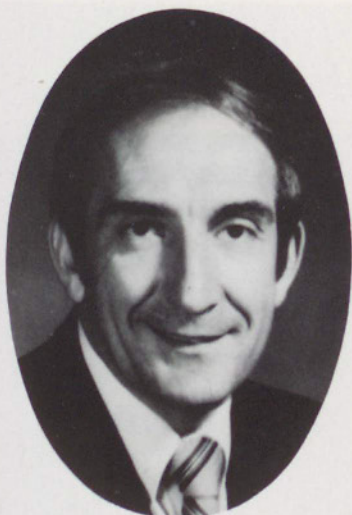
