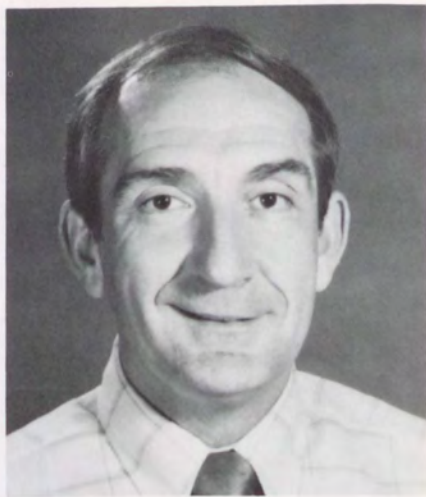


I urge you to offer words of appreciation to all students who labored long without any promise of public recognition preparing this book. It is through their efforts that this annual is available to you.

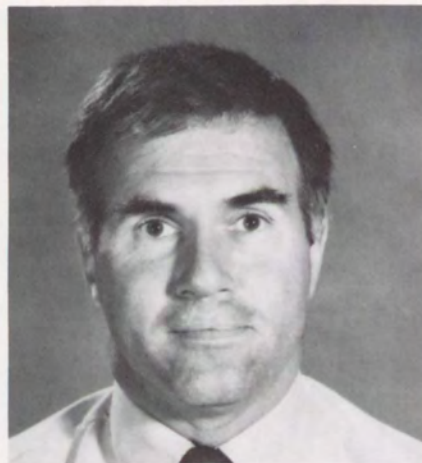
May each of you enjoy a peaceful summer. And to the graduating seniors I extend my congratulations and hopes for a very successful future.

For Julie and Joe, it was truly a trip of a lifetime.

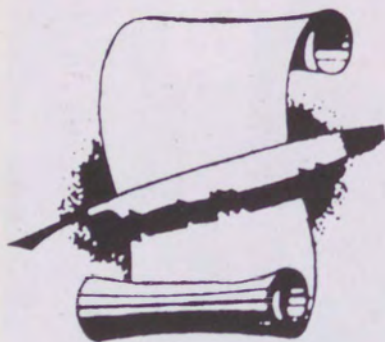
