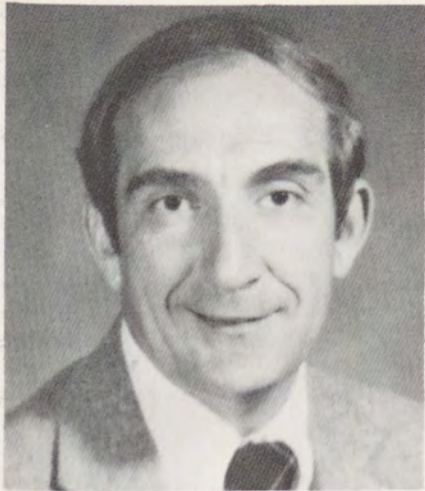
Mr. Floyd has been at John Bapst since 1962 and he has always been known as an extremely honest and courageous teacher.
