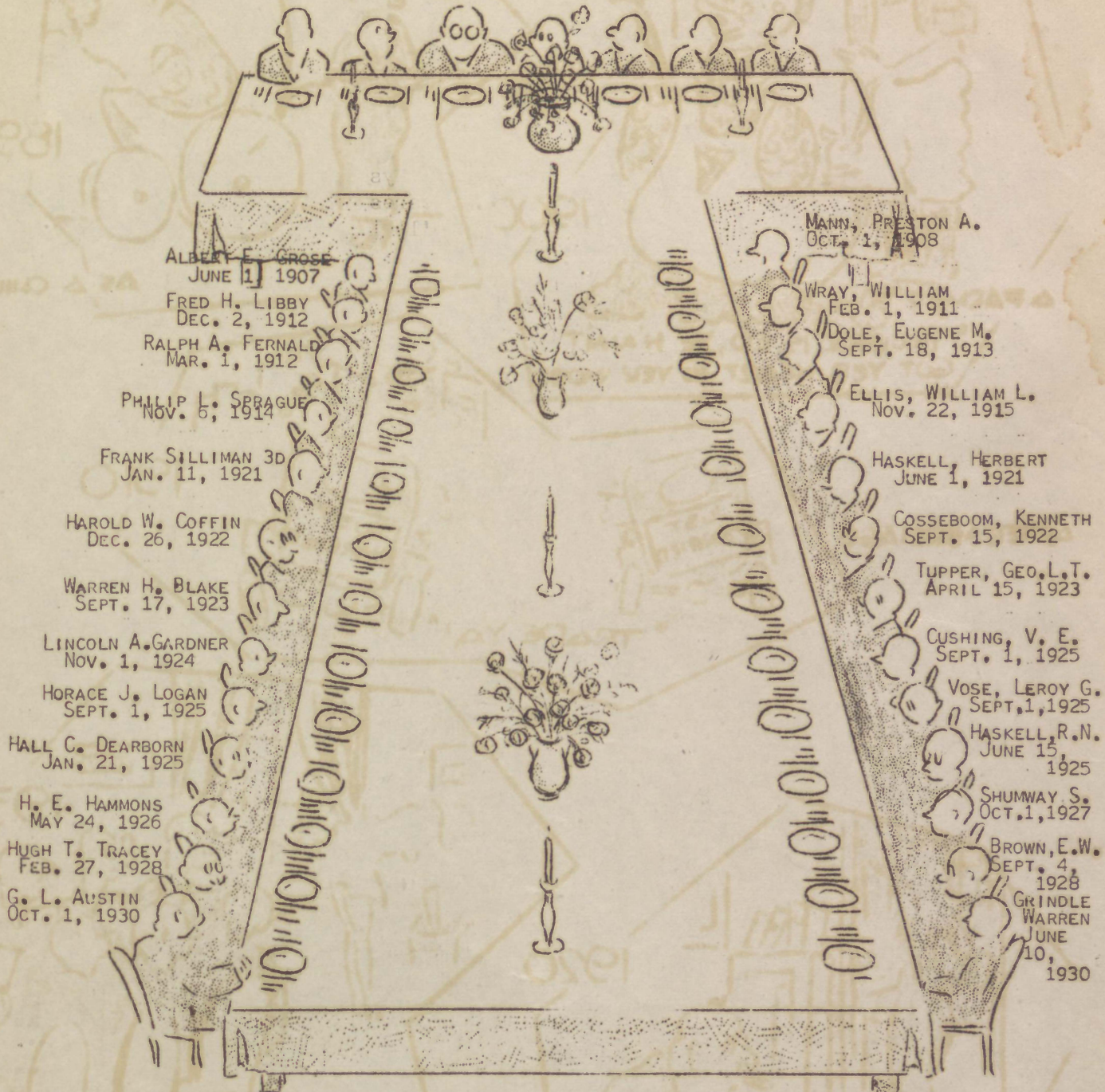

Are your twenty in B. H-E.

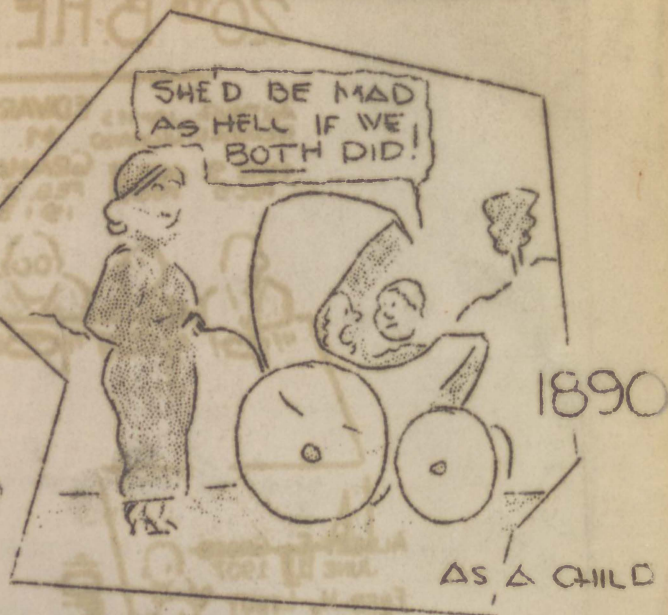

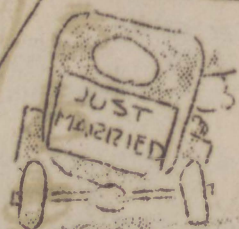

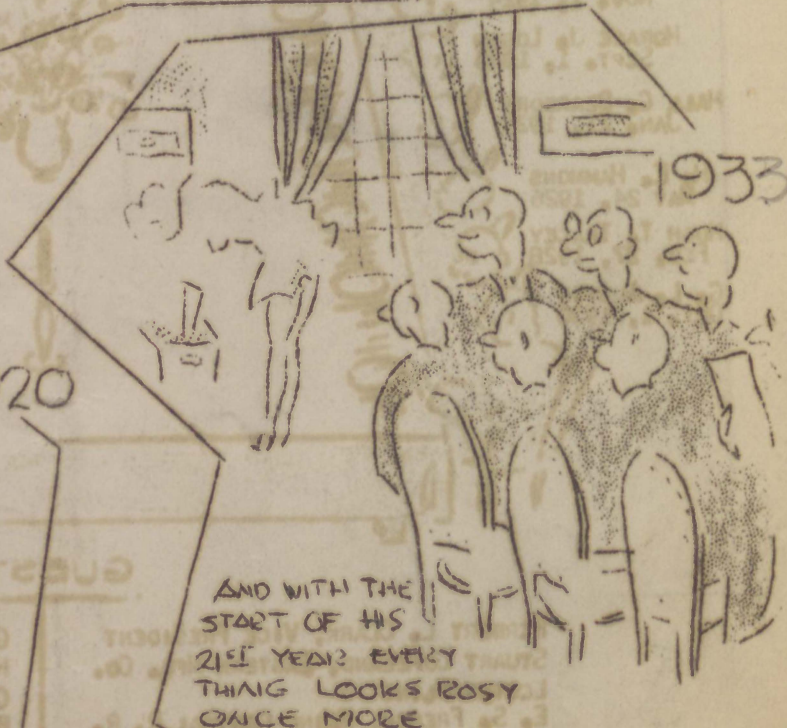
