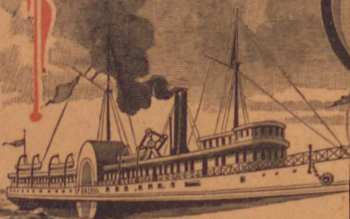

### About Tickets, State- rooms, Meals, Etc.

**R**ATES quoted via this Line do not include rooms and meals. Cabin berths are furnished without charge; meals are served on the steamer at regular hours.

**MEALS:** Breakfasts on steamers of the Main Line, and on steamer "MT. DESERT," are 50 cents each. Noon dinners on all steamers are 75 cents each.

From June 22 to September 22, a **Table d'hôte dinner** (ready at 5.00 P.M.), at \$1.00 per plate, will be served on steamers "CITY OF BANGOR" and "PENOBSCOT."

**Half Fare** is charged for children five years of age and under twelve, children under five years of age being carried free.

**Baggage** is checked to all points to which tickets are sold, 150 pounds being checked free on each full ticket; 75 pounds on half tickets.

The charge for baby carriages is from 50c. to \$1.50, according to size and value.

Rates for the transportation of dogs between Boston and any landing at the East, one dollar. From one river landing to any other, 50 cents.

**Rates for Bicycles** are as follows: 75 cents between Boston and any landing, and 25 cents between any two landings on River or Bay.

Bicycles accompanied by owner in riding costume and without baggage will be transported between Boston and any landing for 50 cents.

**STATEROOMS** on steamers of the BOSTON & BANGOR STEAMSHIP Co. are \$1.50, \$2.00, \$2.50 and \$3.00 each, according to location, and with very few exceptions accommodate two persons. Parlor rooms furnished with wide beds are \$3.00 each. During the Summer season it is advisable to secure accommodations in advance. Staterooms may be engaged in advance of day of sailing. Parties at a distance from Boston can have rooms reserved by mail or telegraph order. Rooms ordered by telephone from Boston telephone stations, or in person at the Boston office, *must be paid for by ten o'clock of day of sailing*, as the rooms cannot be held after that hour unless paid for. The Boston office has no control over rooms on steamers coming from the East. Rooms are apportioned to the several principal landings, and passengers desiring rooms for Boston must engage them at the East. Rooms at all Eastern stations will be reserved upon receipt of paid telegram, or upon application in person and paying for same. Letters ordering rooms at landings East of Boston **must contain one dollar in part payment** for each room wanted. Communications should state destination and must give the address of the writer, in order to insure attention and acknowledgment. When it is not possible to assign such a stateroom as may be desired, the best available room remaining unassigned on receipt of request will be allotted. Passengers requesting stateroom reservations should be particular to give day and date on which accommodations are desired.
