# Football 1967

Under the guiding hands of first-year mentor, Norm Tardiff, and his able assistants, Coaches Bob Gaboury and Jeff Moody, the '67 Crusaders fought their way to a 4-5-1 record in what has been termed a building season. Led by tri-captains John Richards, an All-PTC offensive back, hard-hitting Mike Gould, and dedicated Don Coffin, the fighting Purple opened the season with a 19-6 loss to arch-rival Brewer in a hard-fought, spirit-filled team effort.

In the third tilt of the season versus Rockland the team put on a tremendous display of come-back ball after being down 13-0 at the half-time break. Charlie Dionne put on a fine individual defensive show and topped it off by running a Tiger fumble into the end zone in the final minute of play.

Bouncing back from back to back losses to Winslow and Conference Champs, Belfast, the Crusaders hit their stride against M.C.I., thrashing the Undergrads 53-0, and establishing a new single game school record. Jere Dougherty, John Richards, and Mike Gould all contributed to the final tally, with two touchdowns each. This verdict was followed up with a sound 21-13 win over much-improved Gardiner. John Richards again scored two tallies and pivot man Jerry Nadeau raced a Tiger fumble back 74 yards for the margin of victory.

All-PTC lineman Tim Shannon demonstrated a fine display of defensive talent against a highly-touted Skowhegan squad which edged out the never-say-die Crusaders, 7-0. Following a disappointing 0-0 tie to the always tough Madison Bulldogs, field general Sam Estey, who did an exceptional job throughout the season, directed the fighting Purple to a 39-0 whipping at Lawrence in the season's finale.

## The Story

Starting the season off with a 103-57 trouncing of Rockland, high hopes were raised in the hearts of Crusader fans. However the team was unable to overcome point worthy foes early and late in the season losing such squeakers to Lawrence, 53-55, and Old Town, 68-70 and 73-75. Orono the highest rated of all Eastern Maine teams, barely edged the young Crusaders 59-62 in overtime.

To offset the heart-breaking losses, the Purple hoopsters soundly smashed such teams as arch-rival Bangor, 80-62 and 98-64, cross-river foe Brewer, 80-35 and 76-68. Avenging an earlier loss to Lawrence, the hardwood warriors rolled to an 87-69 victory at the Bangor Auditorium.

Junior Charlie Greer captained the team through the season with his alert and aggressive play while pulling down 17.5 rebounds a game and setting a new school record in collecting 29 bounces versus Lawrence.

Senior Tom Tennett and junior forward Jon Beausang more than complemented Greer's efforts off the boards. Tennett always played brilliant defense and curled in many lay-ups from underneath with a game-high of 21 in the finale. Beausang's long set shots and fine follow-ups made him a constant scoring threat.

Backcourt men Sam Estey and Claude Rioux usually provided a good one-two punch with Estey's flying lay-ups and Rioux's fast-breaking bunnies.

With four of the starting five back next year we should surely gain a berth in the Eastern LL tourney.

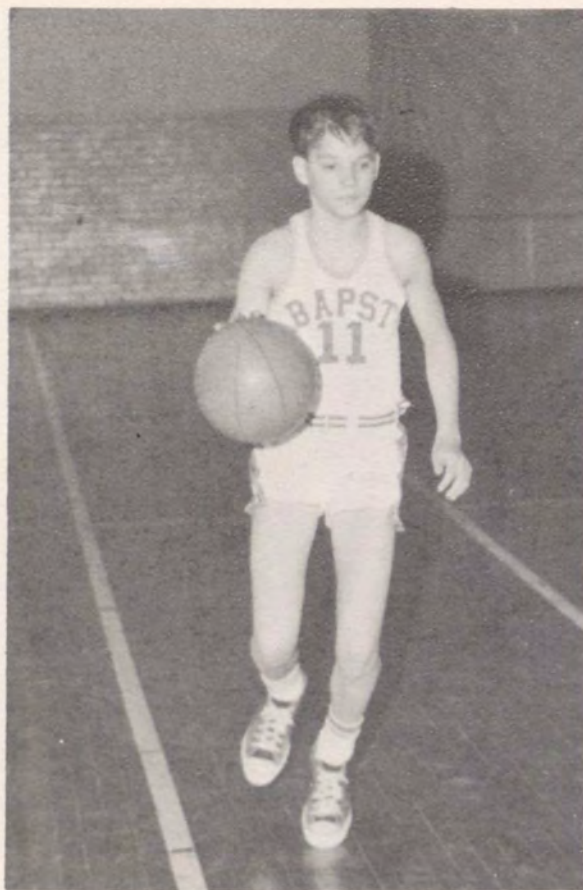

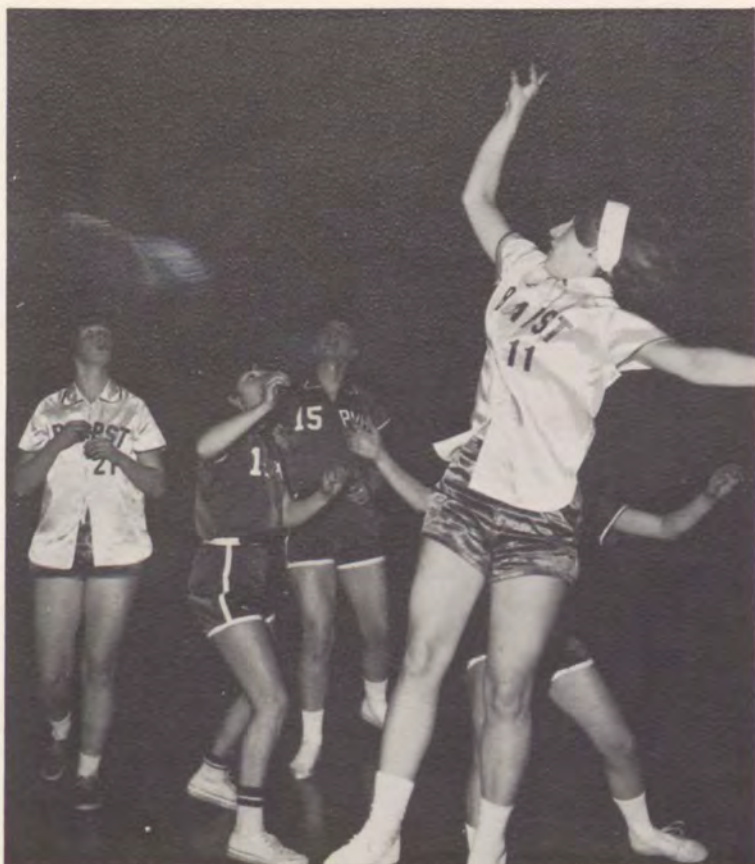
## The Story
