The Commanding Officers

Back in the days when the 714th was known as the 611th Engineer Railway Battalion, no one worked as hard as Colonel Charles E. Hise in shaping up, on paper, the structure of the outfit. Later, upon the redesignation of the unit to the 714th Engineer Railway Battalion, Colonel Hise was named as the Commanding Officer. During the interim between the outbreak of war and the date of activation of the 714th, Colonel Hise labored with untiring zeal to build up the unit with voluntary enlistments in the Engineer Reserve, earmarking them for service with the 714th upon its activation. By the time the outfit was ordered to active duty, more than three-hundred men had signed up with the 714th. October 31st, 1942 was set by the War Department as the mobilization date for the unit and Camp Claiborne was designated as the assembly place. After undergoing a strenuous refresher course, Colonel Hise assumed command of the 714th on the 22nd of November 1942. Life for the men and the officers was not easy in those days at West Claiborne and the men re-named our location, calling it "Goat Hill" due to the preponderance of mutton in the daily diet. Through the dreary days of training and bad weather, Colonel Hise was ever present to lend a sympathetic ear and helping hand to all of us. But Colonel Hise was not destined to remain with the 714th for the War Department had bigger things in store for him. The outfit moved out of Camp Claiborne on the 14th and 16th days of March, 1943, bound for Alaska to bolster our shaky defenses in that theater in the dark and uncertain days before Attu and Kiska, but Colonel Hise was ordered to remain at Camp Claiborne. None of us knew, at that time, why our commander had been left behind, but we were soon to learn that he had been appointed as Director of Railway training for the Military Railway Service with headquarters at New Orleans. He received his promotion to the rank of Colonel shortly after he assumed his new duties. After serving in that capacity for many months, Colonel Hise was ordered to the South Pacific and it was generally known that he would shortly exchange his eagles for the stars of a General Officer. But fortune frowned upon Colonel Hise, almost on the day he was to board the plane that would take him to new successes and service. It was found that his general health would not permit his continuance upon active duty and so with great regret, Colonel Hise put down his burden and returned to the healing regularity of civilian life. A much loved man Charley Hise.

Like many other far-seeing men, Lt. Colonel Herbert S. Huron saw the need for preparedness-minded men in the Reserve Component of the Army of the United States. Realizing that the service would have need for his knowledge of railroad operation coupled with his training as a National Guard Officer, he offered his services to the army and was commissioned a reserve captain in the Corps of Engineers many years before the outbreak of hostilities. It was quite natural therefore that Lt. Col. Huron should be the first Executive Officer of the 714th Engineer Railway Battalion. Captain Huron had already exchanged his bars for the leaves of a Major before he was ordered to active duty at Camp Claiborne. Like Colonel Hise, Major Huron had given his time and money in recruiting the personnel for the battalion before the activation date and had personally secured many highly trained specialists for the unit. The command of the 714th therefore fell upon his shoulders when the outfit was ordered to Alaska. The move through Camp Murray and the Seattle Port of Embarkation was anything but pleasant. However, it is a matter of record that the 714th passed through that staging area faster than any other unit had ever done and to the great credit of Major Huron, he was able to control his feelings and opinions of the "SNAFU" actions of some of the personnel at that staging area. The transport was loaded with dispatch and skill under Major Huron's able direction and at last the 714th was on its way to its ultimate mission. Shortly after the battalion, which was now known as the 714th

Railway Operating Battalion of the Transportation Corps, was on the job, Major Huron's golden leaves turned to silver and he became Lt. Colonel Huron. Colonel Huron demonstrated, time and time again, his great ability to get along with others and to make contacts in the places which would benefit his battalion the most. The immediate problems were at once met and disposed of and the battalion went on to greater fame and achievement. Under Colonel Huron the 714th gained the reputation of being one of the crack units of the Alaskan Defense Command. On the 5th of September 1944, Lt. Col. Huron was relieved of the command of the 714th and flown directly to the European Theater where the War Department had great need of his knowledge and abilities. At this writing, he is still on the continent of Europe solving the transportation problems of the Army. More than thirty-two months of continuous, overseas, service for his country! Good Luck Colonel Huron!

The next Commanding Officer was Lt. Colonel Walter F. Hastedt who succeeded to command when Lt. Colonel Huron was sent to the European Theater. Colonel Hastedt entered World War I as a private and emerged as a 1st Lieutenant in the Corps of Engineers. His career for more than thirty years has centered chiefly around various phases of railroading and it was no surprise, to anyone that knew him, when he offered his rail and military experience to the War Department when peace was so rudely disrupted by the Japs. The Corps of Engineers immediately offered him a Captaincy and he found himself plunged into recruiting the 714th personnel along with Colonel Hise and Lt. Colonel Huron. After a stiff refresher course he found himself in command of Headquarters and Service Company of the 714th Engineer Railway Battalion located on the famous "Goat Hill". Messing is always a problem in the Army and no one came to realize it anymore than did Captain Hastedt. At one time the 714th ran over fifty separate messes extending from one end of the line to the other, nearly five-hundred miles. It was Captain Hastedt's job to see that all of the messes were adequately supplied and staffed. In addition to his mess supervisory duties, Captain Hastedt ran a full company in spite of an acute shortage of officer personnel. On the 1st of February, 1944 Captain Hastedt assumed the duties of Executive Officer of the 714th relieving Major William J. Thomas who had found it necessary to leave the service due to a greater need for him at home. Captain Hastedt was given his Majority on the 16th of June 1944. Major Hastedt has always been a soldier's soldier and the comfort and welfare of the men have been his chief concern throughout his long service. He immediately initiated action to obtain more comforts for the men, the most outstanding of which was the area PX which was designed and laid out with our own forces. So convincing was Major Hastedt's salesmanship, that even Brigadier General, R. E. Mittelstaedt, Commanding General of Fort Richardson, followed its progress with keen interest. Major Hastedt succeeded to command of the 714th on September 5th, 1944 and was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant Colonel on April 20th, 1945. Under Colonel Hastedt, the 714th finished the job in Alaska and left for the United States on May 10th, 1945. At present Col. Hastedt is back in civilian life. During his last ten months of active service he was endeavoring to whip another 714th Railway Operating Battalion in shape for extended field duty. Where? . . . your guess is as good as ours!

The present Commanding Officer is Major Philip E. Barlow who succeeded to command when Lt. Colonel Hastedt elected to return to civilian status. Major Barlow's experience, both army and civilian, fitted him peculiarly for this position of responsibility and trust. His military career started at St. Thomas College, St. Paul, Minnesota, followed by years spent in the Engineer Officers Reserve Corps. His railroad experience was entirely along engineering lines, estimating, planning and executing.

Captain Barlow was assigned to command Co. A immediately upon the activation of the Battalion. Keeping the Claiborne-Polk Military Railway right of way in condition to be used was indeed a test of both his ingenuity and ability.

His company when assembled at Camp Murray just before embarking for Alaska we believe was the largest company in any railway outfit, as it consisted of approximately seven hundred and fifty enlisted men and officers. Those of us who saw the company fall out for roll call will never forget the sight.

Problems of administration and supply in a company of this size was a heavy burden on Captain Barlow. There is an old axiom that if you want a job well done, give it to a busy man. This was evidently believed in and preferred by Lt. Colonel Huron, who detailed Captain Barlow to proceed by plane to Alaska as advance liaison officer to arrange for the billeting and rationing of the Battalion upon its arrival. The latter accomplished this to everyone's satisfaction.

During our tour of duty Co. A's accomplishments under Captain Barlow's direction were many and varied. One would have to write a volume to adequately describe them.

Captain Barlow received his promotion to Major on January 1, 1945 and succeeded to command of the 714th on December 17, 1945.

Closing out old "Crime and Punishment", (Claiborne-Polk) Military Railway was done under his direction and the unit with certain items of Railway equipment left Camp Claiborne on January 4, 1946 for Ft. Eustis, Virginia, where it is now stationed. The name of the Battalion had been changed to 714th TC Railway Operating Battalion and assigned to duty as a regular army unit.

The 714th Railway Operating Battalion was organized many years before Pearl Harbor and it first assumed importance as the 714th Engineer Railway Battalion. Most of its officers were Engineer Reserve Officers and had accepted commissions in the Corps of Engineers many years before war actually broke out. Shortly after the outbreak of hostilities, the commanding officer received instructions to actively pursue recruiting of qualified personnel for the unit. This was done and men came to St. Paul, Minnesota, from far and near to get in on the ground floor of this highly specialized battalion. They came from most of the principal railroads in the entire country. The battalion had originally been sponsored by the Chicago, St. Paul, Minneapolis and Omaha Railway, however when it was finally assembled it truly represented a cross-section of American Railroading. Much pleasant banter and kidding about the superiority of one road over another was always in evidence and the rival factions were constantly ready to be heard.

The activation date of the 714th Engineer Railway Battalion was set for October 31st, 1942 and the place specified was the Engineer Unit Training Center at Camp Claiborne, Louisiana. The Engineer Center was located west of the main camp and had not been built up nor improved as had the other parts of Camp Claiborne. As a result, the men and officers got their first taste of the rugged life when they found themselves quartered in pyramidal tents on the solid dirt floors. And then the rains came, but the basic training went on just the same. Many of the original men will recall their first trip to the range and the caressing mud in which they laid while they peered through the rain at the dancing bulls-eyes. As the training progressed, the tents disappeared and tar-papered barracks replaced them. All will recall the great feeling of luxury that came over us as we moved into the sheltered confines of those ugly shanties. Finally the outfit moved over into the main camp and relieved the 759th on the Camp Claiborne-Polk Railroad. And then the fun began.

Someone had conceived the idea of constructing a Military Railroad from Camp Claiborne to Camp Polk, a distance of about fifty miles. It had been completed by the time we got there, but no one had ever figured out a method for licking the mud. The more it rained, the deeper the track sank into the good old Louisiana mud. The battalion was greatly over-strength at this stage of the game, but it took the entire personnel to keep the track open and the trains running. Derailments were the order of the day and night and many a poor G.I. was aroused from his bed to get out and put the equipment back on the track. Military training was pursued just as diligently as before until G.I. Joe didn't know whether he was in the Army, working on a railroad or riding a horse. About this time the Military Railway Service was transferred, lock, stock and barrel to the Transportation Corps and we all lost our identity as the 714th Engineer Railway Battalion and became known as the 714th Railway Operating Battalion. As the time rolled by, the unit shaped up very rapidly and rumors were rife as to where we were going and when. Eventually the day arrived, but the "switch-shanty" rumors still persisted for no one knew, with certainty, where we were bound.

When the 714th moved over to the Camp Claiborne-Polk Railroad, back in December, 1942, they found the rolling stock and power in very sad shape indeed. "B" Company found themselves up to their necks in work necessitating three shifts around the clock. At first baling wire and pliers did overtime duty in order to keep the power moving so that the "C" Company boys would have something to train with. As things became more organized, the locomotives, one by one, were shopped and put back into serviceable condition. During this period of heavy work, the boys were also obliged to keep up their military training, inspections, parades, etc., so it was no wonder that the men were dog-tired most of the time. However, they came through with flying colors and became one of the best darn "B" Companies in the entire Military Railway Service. They were later to demonstrate just how good they were when they were turned loose on the equipment of the Alaska Railroad.

Of course the wrecking crew put in plenty of overtime and the big hook was never allowed to cool. As fast as the good boys from "C" Company would put them in the ditch, the boys from "B" Company would pick them up. In the meantime the "Gandy-Dancers" from "A" Company rebuilt the track as fast as it was torn up by the derailments. It was a particularly rainy season and most impossible to keep the track in any kind of line or surface. The result was an extremely ticklish job for the lads from "C" Company. At one time it was contemplated to send a Chaplain with every train so that he would be handy to hear the last requests of the engine and train crews when the trains took for the woods. All in all, there was a great deal of misery, more hard work and some fun. Many of the officers got to talking to themselves, but never quite got to the stage of answering themselves so that we were only a little crazy when the sailing day came.

With the 714th in Alaska

Unfortunately, no pictures were permitted of our move out of Claiborne or any of the details of the trip. Most of you will recall that our cameras were taken from us before we boarded the train. Later, we were to find that cameras were permitted in Alaska under certain conditions which allowed the pictorial recording of some of our activities while we were making the Alaska Railroad run.

For the purpose of the record, and for the information of the original outfit that started for Alaska, the 714th left Camp Claiborne under letter order of that camp dated 14th March, 1943. Our orders transferred us to Fort Lewis, Washington where we picked up further orders for Fort Richardson, Alaska, then known as APO 942, U. S. Army, c/o Postmaster, Seattle, Washington. At Seattle we picked up three Track Maintenance Platoons, two of which came from the 715th and one from the 719th Railway Operating Battalions. The strength of the battalion for the mission at hand was 1108 enlisted men, two warrant officers and 23 commissioned officers. Actually, we went aboard with 1092 enlisted men instead of the 1108 due to illnesses, etc., at the last minute.

A liaison officer was flown to Alaska ahead of the unit and arrangements were completed by him for the housing, messing and deployment of the troops upon arrival. On the 3rd of April, 1943, the outfit sailed into the beautiful harbor of Seward. The Navy Transport Chaumont was our home for those hectic days at sea and not very many of the boys escaped the inevitable sea-sickness. The sighs of relief were plainly audible when the Chaumont finally docked at Seward and the G.I.s came streaming down the gang-plank.

The Alaska Railroad, which is owned by the Federal Government and Operated by Department of the Interior, proved to be a most important rail line in our operations against the Japs. It was the only means at hand for supplying the interior of Alaska with personnel and material for the defense of the territory and for setting up the offensive structure for our later moves against the Nipponese. The civilian personnel, even in peace times, had never been sufficient to adequately maintain and operate the line. Consequently, when war came, what few civilians remained were totally unable to keep this vital supply line going. Maintenance of the line was at a very low ebb, to such an extent that many of the structures were unsafe for operation. The mechanical personnel could not begin to cope with the problem of keeping the power and cars in shape for hauling war supplies, and the operating men were very few in number. So few were they that they couldn't have kept the trains rolling if they worked continuously twenty-four hours at a stretch, day after day. The result was a tremendous back-log of material piled up at the port of Seward and the port of Whittier had not been opened for through traffic.

For more than twenty-five months, the men of the 714th kept on the job and made the Alaska Railroad tick. Their efforts were duly appreciated and were finally recognized shortly before the unit returned to the States. By command of Lieutenant General, Delos C. Emmons, Commanding General of the Alaskan Department, the 714th was awarded the Meritorious Service Unit Plaque on 4 April, 1945 and entered the United States on the 24th of May, 1945. After twenty-one days of free time the 714th re-assembled at their old stamping grounds, Camp Claiborne, Louisiana, for re-deployment training. In the meantime, the war with Japan ended, and at this writing, the 714th is at Fort Eustis, Virginia.

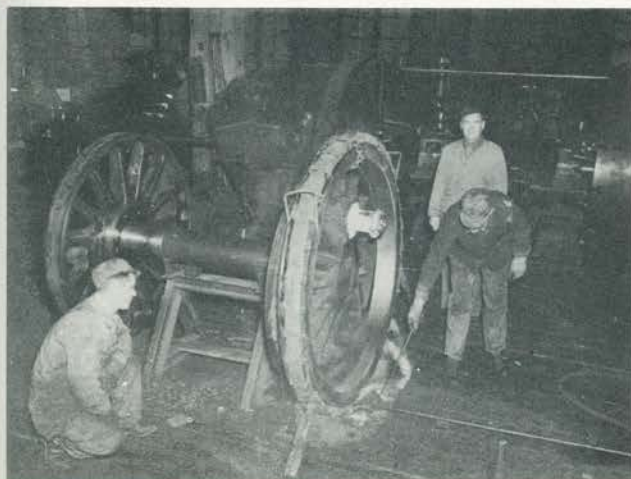

The Battalion Headquarters was located at Anchorage, Alaska, about 114 miles north of the port of Seward. Anchorage was perhaps, the largest town in the territory due to the vast activities at Fort Richardson and Ellemdorf Field. The General Offices of the Alaska Railroad were also located at Anchorage. When the 714th first moved in it was necessary to plan a housing area capable of handling approximately 500 men and officers. As is always true in the army, no one does anything for anyone else unless one pitches in and really tries to help himself. So, while our men were scattered all over the environs of Fort Richardson, some in tents, some in Quonsets and some in barracks, we laid out a camp site and proceeded to salvage some in Quonsets huts which were no longer being used out in the dispersion areas. Most of the huts had to be completely dismantled because of their inaccessability, but some of them were moved many miles using a large trailer and truck. Under the able direction of M/Sgt. Rudsil the camp was rapidly put together and we had ourselves a home at last.

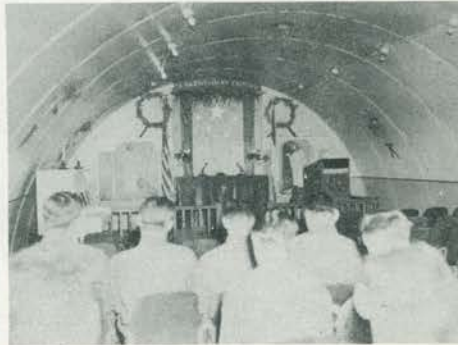

The need for a chapel was immediately apparent both for the Protestant and Catholic men. There were a good many churches in the town of Anchorage of most all denominations. However, the weather often discouraged the boys from making the trek to town to attend services on Sunday mornings. With the help of our good friend, Colonel Maybin Wilson, Post Engineer and Commanding Officer of the 177th Engineer Regiment, we were able to obtain a new Butler Hut which we promptly converted to a chapel. Our first chaplain was Lieutenant Parrish who did not stay with us very long. He was relieved by Chaplain Homiston who was in turn sent to the chain. Chaplain Palmerlee came to us in the exchange and was subsequently appointed Post Chaplain. The last chaplain we had in Alaska was Captain Sparks. At present, the chaplain of the 714th is Lieutenant Norman who joined the outfit when it returned to Camp Claiborne. The new chapel was the scene of one marriage and sadly, two funerals.

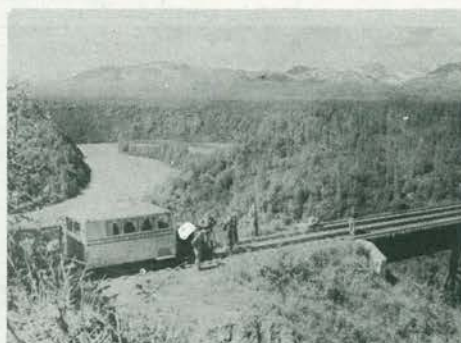


The Post Exchange Services

With the hundreds of men spread out over the entire Alaska Railroad, it became necessary to furnish them with an adequate PX service. We finally obtained an automobile motor-coach and trailer from the railroad and instituted our travelling PX. The Medical Officer and Dental Officer, as well as the Chaplain always accompanied PX train. A complete assortment of the PX necessities was carried as well as the Doctor's supply of the basic drugs. And not to leave the chaplain out, plenty of religious material for all faiths was always available. But the winter time made travel difficult with the motor-coach, especially over the mountains, and we were in constant doubt as to whether the rubber tires would get us through. Blow-outs were common and just as dangerous as they were often. Further, the tires were unobtainable as they were a particular type that carried in the neighborhood of one-hundred pounds of pressure. Finally we decided to enlarge our PX train and go to steam. The enlarged facilities made an occasional trip over the line available to many of the Anchorage-bound personnel who never seemed to go anywhere. Many times sick G.I.s. were taken to the hospital via the PX train. And so it went, the boys in the sticks couldn't get to the post to visit the PX, but we brought the PX to them. And many of them will remember the hundreds of cases of G.I. beer that came to them by their own travelling PX.

Our first PX in the area at Anchorage was set up in an ordinary Quonset Hut, but as we progressed in our relations with the Post, we were able to secure a large Quonset-type Hut with the assistance of our good friend General Mittlestaedt. Fortunately for the 714th, we had a very capable Architect in the person of Sergeant Mike Boggio. When Mike was given the word to go ahead with no holds barred, he designed a PX that was something to really talk about. Permission for the construction was promptly given by the Post and soon the opening day came. Everything was provided except strong drink, however, strange as it seems, the malted milk machines got the biggest play. We did a land-office business every day and it was noticeable that the G.I.s. were getting a little bulgy around the waste. Wednesdays and Saturdays were open house for the boys so that they could bring their lady-friends over from town, see the movies and feed them at the PX. It was a great thing for all concerned and the result was that the local booze-dispensers in the town of Anchorage suffered from the competition. Beer, in the town was forty and fifty cents a bottle while the PX dispensed it for one thin dime. It was with true regret that we left our own, private club to the uncertain hands of the civilians who took our places.

Came the day when the special train set out for its historic trip over the line and with Christmas carols coming forth from the loud-speaker, the train left Anchorage. Many of the old-timers stood on the platform in amazement at the elaborateness of the occasion. Not a few of them had tears in their eyes as the strains of "Holy Night" and "Oh Come All Ye Faithful" came over the winter air. All along the five-hundred miles of line the train passed out its good cheer and Merry Christmases to the boys. As the train came in to each station the loud speaker gave out its message of Christmas cheer and the boys would board the train receive their gifts and participate in a short Christmas service given by the chaplain. And as the train would pull away the boys waved and stood listening until the last note of the Christmas carol being played was swallowed up in the wintery breezes.

This is the tower for the famous Nenana Ice Pool. Known throughout the Northwest and Alaska as the largest lottery of its kind. Every year this huge lottery is held at Nenana, Alaska with people from far and near guessing on the date the ice in the Tanana River will break up. They back their guesses with one dollar a throw, selecting the hour, the minute and the date. Tickets were sold throughout the territory of Alaska, but could not be sold in the United States or Canada. All tickets had to bear an Alaskan address and no money could be sent out of the territory to pay off an absent winner. All of the money collected was put into the pool less the actual administrative costs of running the lottery. Some years the amount paid to the winner or winners, approached the staggering sum of eighty or ninety thousand dollars.

Nenana is a small town located on the Tanana River and is strictly a river port town. The Tanana River flows into the Yukon River and is one of the important communication links of the territory. The marine-ways, warehouses and a few small stores make up the town. It is also a sub-division point of the Alaska Railroad. The population is mostly native with not more than one-hundred whites permanently residing there. One of the most beautiful bridges on the Alaska Railroad is located here having been designed by one of the famous bridge designers of America.

Every year a tri-pod is set up out on the ice of the river and a wire is connected to a tower on shore which contains an electric clock. When the ice breaks up the tri-pod slips down stream, tripping the time clock which records the exact hour, minute and date. The individual who has been fortunate enough to guess the exact time finds himself wealthy for the rest of his life. Very often there are ties so the pool is split up into equal shares. Since the days of the high taxes, people generally go together on tickets so that the income will not be so heavily taxed. Many stories are told of the winnings and the happenings to the people who were fortunate, or unfortunate enough to cut in on the pool. One man at Curry, Alaska, so the story goes, won forty-thousand dollars one year and proceeded to go on a real toot. In exactly one year he was back at Curry, broke and looking for his old job. Asked if he had any regrets, he said no because he had had the time of his life and enjoyed spending every cent of it. Another man won a huge slice of the pool and invested it in drinking emporiums at Fairbanks and Anchorage. Today he is one of the rich men of the territory. And so the stories go, but the rule is constant, a fool and his money . .

Many soldiers, during their tours in Alaska have cut in on the pool, and it was always good news when we heard of some soldier who had gotten a little something extra for his lonely days in Alaska. The Nenana Ice Pool, an Alaskan institution!



And sometimes we had wrecks. Most Northern Railroaders know what it is to have track heave in the winter, but it is doubtful if they ever saw heaves like the ones in Alaska. Ordinary track shims couldn't begin to handle the hills and valleys created by the freezing action. The result was a track that resembled a country road after freeze-up time, limiting the speeds of trains to a walking pace in many locations. Occasionally, some speed merchant would widen on the throttle at the wrong time and just as soon did he find himself in the proverbial ditch. The wreck at Windy was no exception. Along came number 26 with the hogger leaning a little too heavy on old lady luck, but she failed him at the psychological moment. These pictures give a rough idea as to just what happened and it is pretty apparent that speed was an important factor in what took place. July 11, 1943.

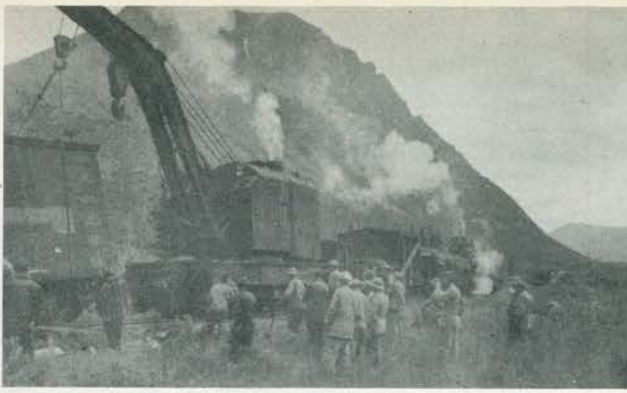

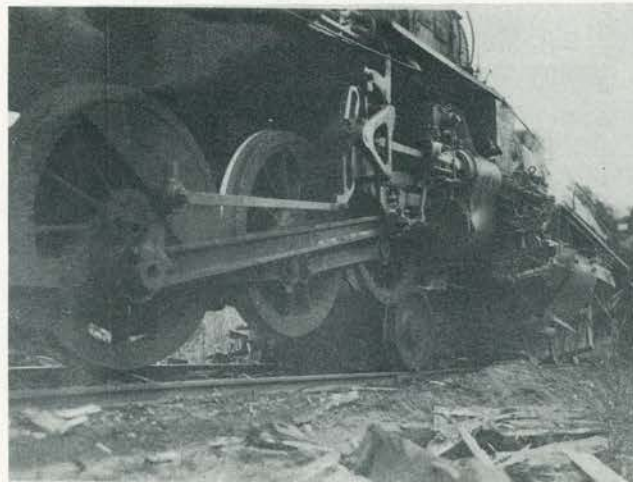

We had our notable visitors too in the persons of five big-leaguers who called on us at our camp in Anchorage. The boys got quite a kick out of meeting and talking with these outstanding stars of the big time. There was Frankie Frisch of the Pirates, Dan Liwhiler of the Cards, Hank Borowy of the Yankees, and later of the Cubs, Dixie Walker of the Dodgers and Stan Musial of the Cards.

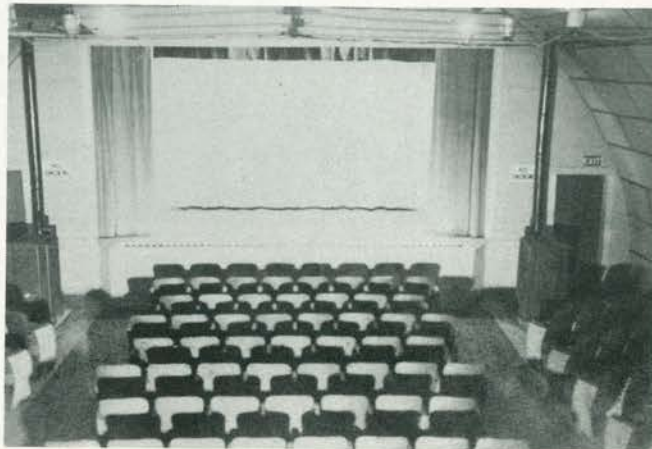
The Motor pool

We leave Alaska

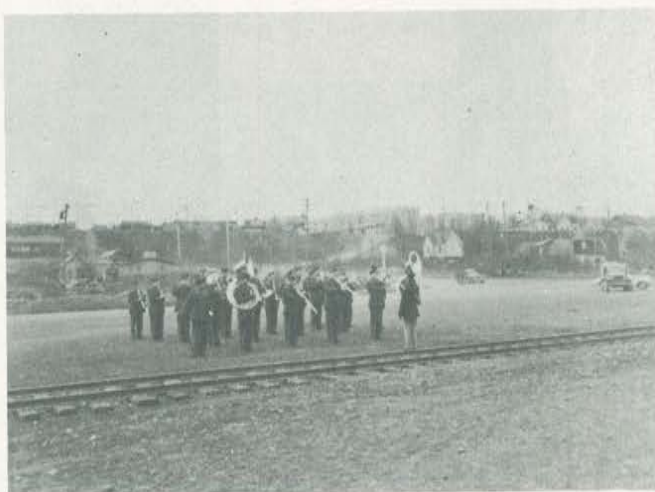
The war picture was changing fast during March and April 1945 and eventually the War Department decided that the 714th should be brought back to the United States, reorganized and retrained for extended field service elsewhere. Company "C" had us going to Ft. Warren, Wyoming, Camp Claiborne, Louisiana, Camp Atterbury, Indiana, Fort Snelling, Minnesota, and even delved into the future predicting our eventual arrival in France, Germany, Philippine Islands, Korea, China and possibly Japan. With a field like this, one of the guesses was bound to be right. We left Anchorage, Alaska on May 10th, embarked from Whittier the same day on the Steamer John W. Branch and took the outside passage. We disembarked at Prince Rupert, Canada on May 12th, reloaded on Canadian National passenger train and unloaded at the Transportation Corps Camp at Port Edwards all on May 12th.

There we made ourselves generally useful around the camp, also enjoying some highly competitive soft ball games between companies and between picked teams from the Battalion and Station Complement. The move out of Port Edwards for those bound east was made on May 20th and those for the west was on May 22nd, handled by the Canadian National. Leaves and furloughs were granted to all of our men for twenty-one days with the exception of the group headed by Lt. Col. Hastedt and under orders to go direct to Camp Claiborne, Louisiana. We crossed from Canada into the United States a few miles south of Winnipeg on May 24th, being taken into St. Paul by the Great Northern Ry, where our train was broken into a great many movements. Those going east on the Chicago Milwaukee St. Paul and Pacific Ry Co and the Chicago Northwestern, the southbound on the Chicago Rock Island and Pacific and the Chicago Burlington and Quincy Ry Co. Lt. Col. Hastedt's detail arrived at Camp Claiborne late in the evening of May 26th. We immediately set up Camp on the north side of the tracks, remaining there until Aug. 7th when we moved south of the tracks to the railway area, taking over the Camp Claiborne-Polk Military Railway from the 770th Ry Opn Bn on that date.

Refresher courses were given the men under the direction of our own officers and non-commissioned officers with the assistance of the 17th group. Replacements came to us from a great many other Railway Battalions, the 730th, 711th, 719th, 725th and the Infantry. Many of our men who were with us in Alaska received their Honorable Discharges, and the rest of us were left to carry on in typical 714th fashion, "Hup tup thrip four."

War Department orders Camp Claiborne closed. War Department redesignates the unit the 714th TC Railway Operating Battalion. 8th service command orders the Battalion to Ft. Eustis, Virginia under the jurisdiction of the 3rd service command, Baltimore, Maryland.

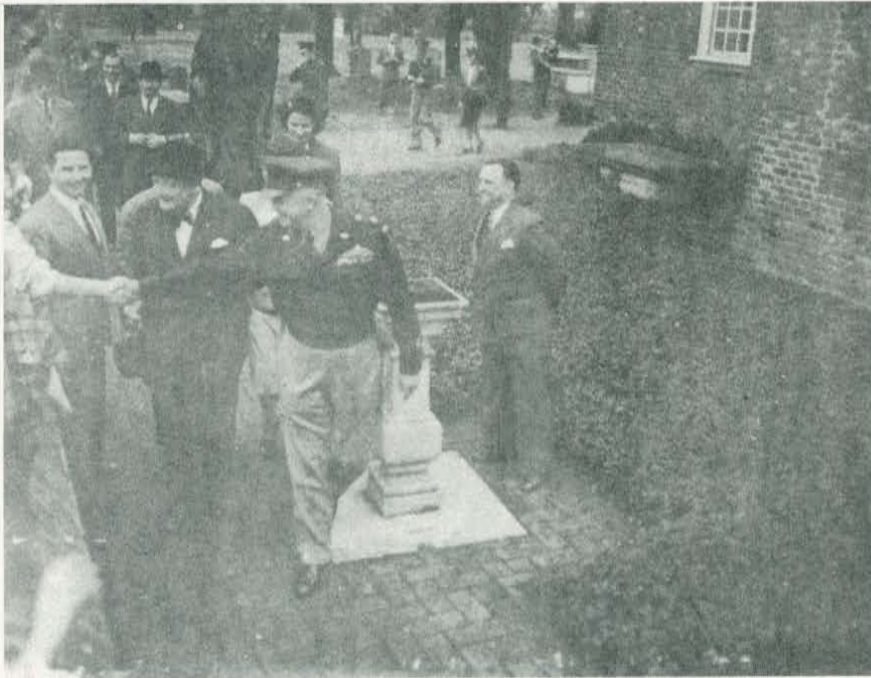
These are the headlines, now for the facts; On January 4th at 10 a.m. we sent our first train out of Claiborne, three locomotives, the wrecker, and forty cars of various kinds. The second train left at 10:30 a.m. with two locomotives, the Pile-driver, the burro crane and forty-one cars. Both trains under the care of Officers and men from B and C companies routed Missouri Pacific, Southern and Chesapeake and Ohio. The rest of us left at 3:30 p. m. the same day on the Missouri Pacific and we passed the two freight trains at Monroe, Louisiana. We pulled into Memphis, Tennessee early the next morning, arrived at Louisville, Kentucky that night, the Illinois Central handled that part of our trip. We left Louisville on the Chesapeake and Ohio without delay and arrived at Ft. Eustis, Virginia the next day late in the evening.

Ft. Eustis was formerly a Coast Artillery installation, but has since been taken over by the Chief of Transportation, and trained here will be Railway, Port, Amphibious and other transportation Corps units. When the Fort reaches its full strength there will be approximately eight thousand soldiers here. It is located on Mulberry Island, but is rather more a peninsula, the James and York rivers forming the boundaries. Most of the GIs prefer it to Camp Claiborne. The cities of Richmond, Williamsburg, Newport News and Norfolk are located close by. Paved roads are good, there are a great many points of historical interest to be seen, as Virginia was the scene of many Revolutionary and Civil war battles. Yorktown where Cornwallis surrendered is but a short distance away from our camp. Jamestown Island where Captain John Smith brought his early settlers in 1600 has been of interest to a great many of our men. Colonial Williamsburg is one of the most historic cities in America, settled in about 1633. Virginia however, does not live in the past, but rather is keeping up with modern progress, therefore you have a combination of both old and new.
