

Whereas the County Commissioners of said Penobecot County did in the month of September, A. D. 1907, make an inspection of all County roads and other roads, originally located as town roads in unincorporated townships and tracts of land in said Penobecot County as required by Section 58, Chapter 9 of the Revised Statutes, in order to make an estimate of the amount needed to put said roads in repair, so far as to be safe and convenient for public travel.

Now therefore, the said County Commissioners upon due inspection as aforesaid, adjudge and estimate that the amount needed to put the roads aforesaid in repair in the several townships hereafter named, so that the same shall be safe and convenient for public travel is as follows:

D. 1907, turther consider and adjudge that the aforesaid sums shall be wholly assessed upon the respective townships according to the estimate made aforesaid for the purpose aforesaid and no part thereof on the County of Penobscot, because the same will not be uncasonably burdensome to the owners of the townships. the townships.
